

TeamCall CA Innovaphone – Release Notes

Changes

Device selection

- Changed the selection of the device to be used for outgoing calls for users with multiple devices (e.g., softphone and desktop phone). (#14195)
 - **New behavior:** The softphone will be used if it is available, otherwise the first registered device will be used.
 - **Previous behavior:** The first registered device will be used, regardless of whether or not a softphone is available.
 - See description of the configuration file parameter `useSoftphoneAsPreferredDevice` in the admin guide for details including how to revert to the previous behavior.

Linux

- CA Innovaphone for Linux is now distributed **as a Docker image**. (#13222, #14205)

Documentation

- Major update of the Admin guide. (#13582, #14206)

Security

- Updated third party libraries, addressing five potential vulnerabilities.

Bugfixes

Service activity

- Fixed a major problem that was triggered in some cases of stopping a device monitor. (#14235)
If it occurred, this problem could have had far reaching followup effects, up to the service no longer responding.
- Fixed two problems that could have prevented CA Innovaphone from successfully reconnecting to the innovaphone system after the system was restarted or after network connection problems. (#13881)
- Fixed a problem that could have prevented the service from shutting down on Windows. (#14218)

Requests and Events

- Retrieving a held call will now reliably cause the expected *RetrievedEvent* to be sent. (#14203)
Before, the expected event was not sent for retrieved outbound calls (even though the retrieve request succeeded).
- Fixed several problems that could combine to cause wrong request timeout messages to be sent to the client (even though there was no timeout and the request was successful). (#14204)
- If the client terminates a call, it will now receive both a *ConnectionClearedEvent* and a *CallCleared Event* (instead of two *ConnectionClearedEvents*). (#14213)
- Fixed a bug where an inbound call could not be accepted after a previous outbound call took place. (#14215)

Installation / Deinstallation

- The Windows installer is now able to handle passwords containing space characters. (#14219)
- When searching for installed JVMs, the Windows installer no longer attempts to use a 32 bit JVM on a 64 bit Windows system. (#14242)
This would not have worked because CA Innovaphone does not support a 32 bit JVM.
- Fixed localization issues in the German language GUI of the Windows installer. (#14186)
- The macOS uninstall script is no longer installed without execute permissions. (#14229)
